Mathematics

This term we will begin by focusing on number and place value (of numbers up to one million). We will also be developing mental and written strategies of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Other areas we are learning about this term include calculating perimeter and area of simple and then more complex shapes, and statistics—looking at drawing and interpreting graphs, tables and charts.

As usual we will be practising arithmetic skills and the children will be using rapid recall boards to practise the skills expected from them in Year 5.

Please continue to practise times tables as this has such a positive impact on learning in maths.

Homework will be given weekly and is due in on Mondays.

Science

Autumn 1 involves looking at forces; including gravity, air and water resistance, friction and how using mechanisms can mean only a small force can have a greater effect. Autumn 2's topic is materials and their properties. We will be separating mixtures, looking at reversible and non-reversible changes and extending our knowledge of solids, liquids and gases.

<u>Topic</u>

Our Geography topic is South America. We will be using maps and atlases to locate different places. We will look at the physical and human features of South America and compare it to our locality. In Autumn 2 we will move to History—studying World War II—the main events and impact on Great Britain. This will involve a visit to Eden camp—an open air museum dedicated to wartime Britain.




Enalish

We are starting this year reading The Great Kapok Tree. We will be writing non-chronological reports about rainforests, explanations about how chocolate is made and persuading people to travel to South

After half term we will be reading Goodnight Mister Tom. This will include writing about the Christmas Truce, a diary entry and looking at World War II poet-

ry.

Computing This term will begin by looking at E-safety and staying safe on the internet. We will be using the internet for research. In the second half of the term we will be looking at digital mapping including google Earth.

<u>RE</u> This term in RE we will be looking at Christianity, including Jesus and Christian lifestyles and celebrations. We will also be learning about Hinduism and visiting a Hindu temple.
