Areas of Learning

The theme for our learning this term is 'Into the Woods'. In **English** we will be reading a range of stories set in forests including Hansel and Gretal, Rumplestiltskin and Golidilocks.

In **Art and DT**, Ms Newell will be introducing the children to art using natural materials, focussing on the work of Andy Goldsworthy among others.

In **Science** as well as learning about the many plants and animals that can be found in forests, we will be learning about the weather and the seasons.

In **Maths** we will continue to use a variety of methods to develop mastery skills, in addition and subtraction, and practice using mathematical vocabulary to explain our thinking. We will be introducing an online maths program, 'Mathletics' to support the teaching and learning that takes place at school.

Phonics As some of you may be aware all Year One children in England are screened for phonics towards the end of the year. We will continue our daily phonics sessions as usual this term with a stronger focus on the national screening in the Summer Term. More details to follow.

<u>Reading</u>

There are lots of opportunities to read in Year One and we expect children to read daily with an adult at home. This could be: • Your child's school reader

- Class library book
 - Bug Club book
- A book of their own Please make sure that reading at home is recorded in the yellow reading diary. School reading book and diary should be returned to school EVERY day for our records.

CLASS LIBRARY will be open every Friday from 8.30 – 8.45 with a range of books to support our topic work.

Homework

Homework will be handed out on a Thursday. Homework should be completed and returned by Wednesday each week.
