<u>Topics</u>

In **Geography** lessons, Y1 will be carrying out some work on the local environment. How to help at home.

- Daily reading and sharing stories with your child – ask questions about what they are reading, play word games and spot rhyming words
- Play games involving numbers dice and domino games are great for this!
- Encourage your child to complete their homework tasks regularly.
