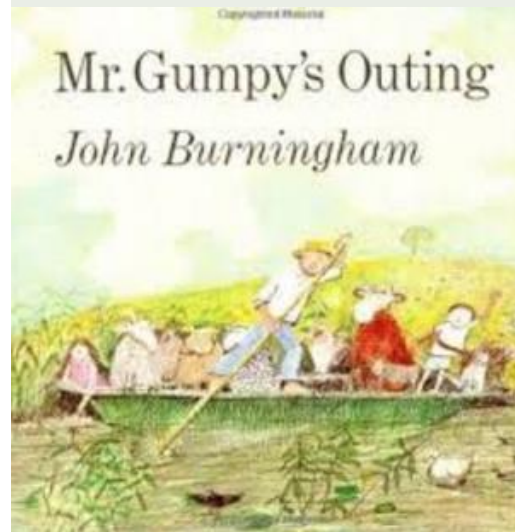
Hope you had a fab Christmas break! We are looking forward to a great term in Reception.

Overall Topic: Travelling Mr Gumpys Outing

- Talk about holiday locations, and different types of holidays. Have they been on holiday? Where might Mr Gumpy want to go on holiday?
- Look at different forms of transport, make a list or draw pictures about the different types of transport.
- Look and talk about animals and their babies
- Visit a farm to look at different farm animals
- Talk time - special times and events (e.g. holidays)
- Mr Gumpy lives in a house by a river. Can you look on a map and find some houses by a river? Which one might Mr Gumpy live in?
- What is your house near? A river? A shop? A park? Can you find your house on a map? Can you draw a picture of your house and who lives there?
