This is clearly not acceptable and cannot be tolerated. It is upsetting and disturbing for our lovely community, other parents, children and staff alike to be subjected to this sort of behaviour. I therefore respectfully insist that we all work together in these difficult times to be mindful of language and behaviour around others.

<u>Uniform</u>

Thank you for your support in ensuring that the children are looking very smart in their uniforms. P.E kit is another essential part of our uniform, and I would ask that children bring their kit to school only on their PE Days, which they can bring in a back pack/bag. Please note we have a **no jewellery** policy in school therefore earrings are not to be worn. Pupils can wear a wrist watch.

School Lunches and Free School Meals

School Lunches have started again this week, the menus are available on the school website. Please note lunches should be paid in advance.

Pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free lunch under the Universal Offer provided by the government. **EVEN** if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or 2 and you are in receipt of benefits please apply for Free School Meals (please ring or email the school office).

Please note for safeguarding purposes we must have 2 valid contacts for each child Thank you for your cooperation. 		We have a number of children in school with nut allergies. For their safety please make sure that your child's packed lunch does not contain any nuts or traces of nuts. Many thanks for your cooperation.	
Operation EncompassNew Delaval Primary is part of initiatives promoted by Northumberland County Council together with Northumbria Police to support better communication between key agencies to promote the safeguarding of children. You will be aware that as a result, following any domestic abuse incident being reported to the police, the Police will make contact with Children's Social Care who will then communicate relevant and necessary information to nominated school staff. This will ensure that the school is made aware at the earliest possible opportunity and can subsequently provide support to children in a way that means they feel safe and listened to (Operation Encompass).The same procedure also happens if for any reason a child goes missing from home. As a result of better multi-agency communication, information about this will be shared with schools (Operation Endeavour).
