You may hear your child talking about "Good to be Green."

This is a Behaviour Management Scheme which encourages positive behaviour in and around our school. Yellow and red cards may be given for negative behaviour and green and silver "privilege cards" are awarded for positive behaviour.

- Please arrive at school for 8.45 am and collect at 3:15 pm. It is essential that you are prompt in the morning and in the afternoon.
- Please name ALL clothing.
- Your child has a designated "Key Worker" in Reception. This is the member of staff you would approach if you have any queries concerning your child's progress.
