Dear Parents/Carers

A big welcome back to pupils old and new as we start a new school year. I do hope you are happy with how your child is settling into their new class. Can I remind parents/carers of the following;

Uniform

Thank you for your support in ensuring that the children are looking very smart in their uniforms. A P.E kit is another essential part of our uniform, and I would ask that children bring their kit to school on Monday's and keep it in school all week taking it home on Friday. We will attempt to provide a kit if your child does not have one for their session however, there will be a consequence of attending homework break the following day.

Please note we have a **no jewellery** policy in school therefore earrings are not to be worn. Pupils can wear a wrist watch.

School Lunches and Free School Meals

Our children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free lunch under the Universal Offer provided by the government. **EVEN** if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or 2 and you are in receipt of benefits and entitled to Free School Meals it is very important that you apply (please contact the school office for advice).

Medical Information

If your child has a medical condition that school should be made aware of, please contact the school office so that we can update our records. For those children that we already have recorded as having a medical issue, forms will be sent out to update information and I would ask that these are returned to the office as soon as possible.

Attendance and Punctuality

Good attendance and punctuality is essential at New Delaval Primary. Doors open at 8:30am and close at 8:45am. Children arriving after this time must contact the school office from intercom system at the gate. If your child's attendance falls below 90% they will be noted as a persistent absentee and will be referred to our Education Welfare Officer.

Admissions for Year 7 and Reception 2022

The portal is now open for Year 7 admissions please note this will close on 31st October 2021. The Reception application portal will open on 1st November 2021 and close on 15th January 2022.

Please note this application process is important and applications should be made on time.
